Gas prices keep climbing

Ohio gasoline prices continue their climb toward the \$4 mark. The average price for regular gas is \$3.74 in Monday's survey from auto club AAA, the Oil Price Information Service and Wright Express. That's up 8 cents from a week ago, when the average was \$3.66. At this time last year, drivers were paying about \$3.47 as prices were soaring toward record highs.
