Established in 1982 by the Florida Supreme Court, Board Certification recognizes attorneys' special knowledge, skills, and proficiency in various areas of law, and professionalism and ethics in practice, thereby helping consumers identify specialists in various areas of law. Only seven percent of eligible Florida Bar members (approx. 5,200 lawyers) are Board Certified Specialists.

The Florida Bar is the organization of all lawyers who are licensed by the Supreme Court of Florida to practice law in the state. Any lawyer desiring to practice law in Florida must be a member of The Florida Bar. To date, more than 100,000 attorneys are in good standing and eligible to practice law in Florida.
